# The Literacy Corner

## Summer 2018



### WHAT IT IS:

- A four-week comprehensive literacy tutoring program for children/youth ages 6 to 14 needing additional support in literacy. Participating children should have completed kindergarten.
- The tutoring sessions include reading, writing, speaking, listening, and viewing activities in one-to-one, one-hour sessions.
- Students will meet periodically with others in sharing sessions.
- Taught by graduate-level, certified teachers in Furman's Masters of Arts in Education program with a concentration in literacy.

### WHEN IT IS:

- **June 11-July 3, 2018**  
(Weeks 1-3: Mondays through Thursdays, Week 4: Monday and Tuesday only).  
Times: 1) Students who have finished kindergarten, 1st or 2nd grades: **9 a.m.-10 a.m.**  
2) Students who have finished grades three and up: **10:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m.**

### WHERE IT IS:

- James B. Duke (Main) Library, Furman University

### COST:

- The charge to each student who attends is \$100. We will notify you of your child's acceptance into the program no later than Wednesday, May 2. No deposit is required until after your child is accepted. We have a limited number of partial scholarships available.

### WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT:

- An assessment of your child's specific literacy abilities in reading, writing, speaking, listening, and viewing at the beginning of the program. A unique program will then be determined for your child.
- An assessment of progress during the program and a final report, which may be shared with you and your child's school officials.
- A one-to-one setting with individual attention and ongoing communication with your child's tutor. Tutors will provide suggestions for reading and writing at home each day.
