The Story of Energy offers a fun and interactive way to learn about electricity. Visitors of all ages will discover how energy is made from water, coal and uranium. The self-guided tour lets you explore at your own pace; but, on average, it takes 30 to 45 minutes to complete. To ensure you have plenty of time to experience all the exhibits, you'll want to begin your tour by 4:15 p.m. afterwards; children can enjoy testing what they learned on our video games.
